Elementary schools slated for closure

Two elementary schools in the East Credit area of Mississauga will close next June.

Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board trustees voted 6-5 in favour of shuttering St. Gertrude Separate School and St. Dunstan Elementary School at Tuesday night's regular board meeting.

The decision concludes a Pupil Accommodation Review (PAR) that began in the area last November. That process also included Our Lady of Good Voyage, St. Gregory, St. Valentine, St. Raymond, St. Herbert and St. Bernadette elementary schools.

Planning staff presented its final recommendation Tuesday at the Catholic Education Centre that called for the closing of St. Dunstan, St. Valentine and Our Lady of Good Voyage.

However, after the report was received, trustee Anna da Silva presented a motion that trustees approve the closure of St. Dunstan and St. Gertrude by June 2017.

The motion proposed that Dunstan students living north of Eglinton Avenue would move to
